

Clemson Roku Set Up

WIRELESS CONNECTION

This guide outlines how to register your Roku with NetReg at Clemson.
You must complete these steps before activating your Stream 2 account.

what you need

Roku 2+ Streaming Stick
TV

register with NetReg

- 1 Go to <https://netreg.clemson.edu>.
- 2 Log in with your University username and password.
- 3 Select **Add Registration** on the left of the screen.
- 4 Enter the **MAC Address** for the Roku device in the format XX:XX:XX:XX:XX:XX in the box labeled Hardware Address.

To obtain the MAC address for your Roku device:

Connect your Roku to your TV, from the **Connect to the Internet** screen, select **Wireless**. Scroll to the "scan again to see all networks" tab. Note the MAC address on the right of the screen.

- 5 Enter the **Device Description**.
- 6 Select **I Agree** at the bottom of the screen.
- 7 **Log Out** by closing the browser window.

connect to Resmedianet

- 1 From the **Choose your network** screen, select **Resmedianet**.
- 2 Enter the network key/password **tigerpaw**.
- 3 Once your Roku is connected to the network, it will **Update** and **Restart**.
- 4 Follow instructions to **Activate your Roku**.

add the Stream2 channel

- 1 From your **TV**, open **Roku**.
- 2 On the **Home Screen** select **Add Channels**.
- 3 Search for **Apogee Stream2** in the channel store
- 4 Select **Add Channel**.

activate your Stream2 account

- 1 Open the **Stream2** app on your TV.
- 2 Type in **Clemson University** for your institution.
- 3 Log in using your **University username and password**.
- 4 Once logged in, follow the directions to **Activate the Device**.
