- Must be enrolled as a Clemson University student in spring 2022 semester.
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.25 at time of submission of application.
- · Lived in University Housing for a minimum of one semester.
- Required to live on campus from May 9-August 9, 2022.
- · Valid driver's license.
